SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, termination dates are established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset Committee. After the review process is completed, the committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which either continue, terminate, or continue with modification each agency reviewed.

This bill would provide for the continuance of the Department of Insurance until October 1, 2024.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the existence and functioning of the Department of Insurance until October 1, 2024.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
3 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Department
4 of Insurance until October 1, 2024.

5 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the
6 Department of Insurance, created and functioning pursuant to
7 Section 27-2-1, specifically, and Title 27, generally, Code of
8 Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1, 2024, and those
9 code sections are expressly preserved.

10 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
11 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
12 Sections 1 and 2.

13 Section 4. This act shall become effective
14 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
15 its otherwise becoming law.
