19	Section 2. The Ashland City Council, by ordinance,
20	may permit the sale of draft or keg beer by retail licensees
21	of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for on-premises
22	consumption and for off-premises consumption. Beer sold for
23	off-premises consumption may not exceed 288 ounces per
24	customer per day which must be sealed, labeled, packaged, and
25	taxed in accordance with state and federal laws and
26	regulations. The city council, by ordinance, may otherwise

regulate the sale of draft or keg beer by retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board within the municipality. Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
