## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

No person elected or appointed Sheriff of Walker County, Walker County Revenue Commissioner, Walker County Commissioner, or any other elected or appointed Walker County official may assume a supernumerary office after the effective date of this amendment. Any person who, on the effective date of this amendment, is participating in a supernumerary program as a supernumerary sheriff shall not continue to participate in that supernumerary program, and may purchase service credit in the Employees' Retirement System for the time the official served in office. Any person who, on the effective date of this amendment, is participating in a supernumerary program other than serving as a supernumerary sheriff may continue to participate in that supernumerary program, which shall include the assumption of a supernumerary office according to the terms and conditions of the law which established that supernumerary program. Every sheriff and other elected or appointed Walker County official holding office at the time of the ratification of this amendment may participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama upon the same terms and conditions as may be specified by law for any other employee in the same retirement system. Walker County officials holding office at the time of ratification of this

amendment shall be eligible to purchase service credit in the 1 2 Employees' Retirement System for the time the official has served in the current office; provided, however, the official 3 shall forego the assumption of a supernumerary office. 4 5 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the 6 7 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 9 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 10 state. Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 11 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 12 13 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of 14 15 the proposed constitutional amendment: 16 "Relating to Walker County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that 17 18 elected and appointed officials in Walker County may participate in the Employees' Retirement System in lieu of 19 20 participating in a supernumerary program or system. 21 "Proposed by Act ." 22 This description shall be followed by the following language: 23 24 "Yes ( ) No ( )."
