6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 Relating to Russell County; providing for an
8 additional expense allowance and salary for the revenue
9 commissioner.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. Commencing on the first day of the month
12 immediately following the effective date of this act, the
13 Revenue Commissioner of Russell County shall receive an
14 additional expense allowance in the amount of twelve thousand
15 dollars (\$12,000) per annum, which shall be in addition to all
16 other expense allowances, compensation, or salary provided by
17 law. Payment of this expense allowance shall be prorated and
18 payable in the same manner and from the same funds as the
19 salary the revenue commissioner is receiving on the effective
20 date of this act. The expense allowance provided by this act
21 shall be treated in the same manner as salary for the purposes
22 of retirements benefits, and the same percentage contribution
23 shall be deducted from the expense allowance and paid into the
24 retirement program for ad valorem tax officials as is deducted
25 from the salary of the revenue commissioner.

1 Section 2. Beginning with the expiration of the term
2 of the incumbent revenue commissioner, the annual salary for
3 the revenue commissioner shall be increased by twelve thousand
4 dollars (\$12,000) per annum, and, at that time, Section 1
5 shall be repealed.

6 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
7 first day of the third month following its passage and
8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
