6 trip to Washington, D.C., to participate in the NASSP  
7 Principal of the Year Awards Program is provided by AASSP;  
8 additionally, an office makeover is provided by Interior

10           WHEREAS, Dr. Clemons has served as President of the  
11 Calhoun County Principals and Coaches Association; he serves  
12 on the Executive Board of Auburn Christian Fellowship at  
13 Auburn University; he has made presentations at conferences or  
14 events for the National Association of Secondary Principals,
