7	WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the
8	death on August 12, 2019, of former State Forester C.W. "Bill'
9	Moody, at the age of 89; and
10	WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of
11	his loving family, many friends, and the entire community,
12	where he was highly regarded; and
13	WHEREAS, in 1970, after serving the Florida Forest
14	Service for many years, Mr. Moody became Alabama's State
15	Forester; one of the first tasks he completed was build the
16	Alabama Forestry Commission (AFC); also, he coined the phrase,
17	"Making Alabama a Better Place for People Through Forestry",
18	which became the motto of AFC; and
19	WHEREAS, Mr. Moody always motivated his employees
20	and supplied the AFC with the proper equipment, training, and
21	resources; while building the AFC family, he also built
22	programs and coalitions to help implement and promote AFC's
23	programs, including the TREASURE Forest Program; TREASURE is
24	an acronym for Timber Recreation Environment and Aesthetics
25	for a Sustained, Usable Resource; in 1986, Mr. Moody

1	established a TREASURE Forest Advisory Committee; later, the
2	committee became the Board of Directors of the TREASURE Forest
3	Landowners Association, which annually presents an award in
4	Mr. Moody's name to a TREASURE Forest landowner who
5	exemplifies the spirit of sustainability and usability that
6	Mr. Moody instilled in the program; over the course of 23
7	years, Mr. Moody continued to have an astounding impact on the
8	forestry and natural resources of Alabama, and his legacy
9	still continues today; and
10	WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly
11	missed, the memory of Mr. Moody will be cherished in the
12	hearts of all who knew and loved him; now therefore,
13	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
14	HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the death of Mr. C.W. "Bill"
15	Moody is recorded with deep sadness, and this resolution is
16	offered in tribute to his life, along with heartfelt sympathy
17	to his family, whose grief is shared by many.
