8 SYNOPSIS: This bill makes a supplemental appropriation  
9 of federal funds from the American Rescue Plan Act  
10 - Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Revenue  
11 Replacement Fund to the Department of Corrections -  
12 Correctional Capital Improvement Fund in the amount  
13 of \$400,000,000 for the fiscal year ending  
14 September 30, 2022.

20 To make a supplemental appropriation of federal  
21 funds from the American Rescue Plan Act - Coronavirus State  
22 Fiscal Recovery Revenue Replacement Fund to the Department of  
23 Corrections - Correctional Capital Improvement Fund in the  
24 amount of \$400,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September  
25 30, 2022.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1           Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations  
2 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
3 \$400,000,000 in federal funds from the American Rescue Plan  
4 Act - Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Revenue Replacement  
5 Fund to the Department of Corrections - Correctional Capital  
6 Improvement Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
7 2022, to be used for the construction of a specialized men's  
8 prison facility and an Escambia men's prison facility as  
9 enumerated in Section 14-2-12, Code of Alabama 1975, as  
10 amended by HB\_\_\_ of the 2021 1st Extraordinary Session of the  
11 Legislature. Any amount of this appropriation remaining  
12 unexpended on September 30, 2022, shall be reappropriated to  
13 the entity for the same purpose for the fiscal year beginning  
14 October 1, 2022. This appropriation of the American Rescue  
15 Plan Act - Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Revenue  
16 Replacement Fund is made pursuant to Section 9901 of the  
17 American Rescue Plan Act amending Title VI of the Social  
18 Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 801 et seq, to add Section 602 which  
19 allows for the certification of funds to carry out the revenue  
20 replacing activities specified in section 602(c)(1)(C) of the  
21 Act.

22           Section 2. This act shall become effective  
23 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
24 upon its otherwise becoming law.
