The report shall include all of the following, as they relate to each plan or project proposal submitted to the division during the preceding fiscal year relating to a public K-12 school:
- (1) The name of the public K-12 school at which the project will take place.
  - (2) The final cost of the project.
- (3) Any increase in cost of a project due to any requirement of or change to the plan or proposal requested by the division, and the reason for that increase.
- (4) For each document submitted to the division for review or approval, the time elapsed between the receipt of the document and the return of the document to the submitting party or other appropriate response by the division.

9	Management approved safe space or hallway rated for tornadoes.
10	"(b) The State Department of Postsecondary Education

14	Management to develop, adopt, and enforce any rules necessary
