16 require time or temperature control for safety to limit  
17 pathogenic microorganism growth or toxin formation and that  
18 does not include meat, poultry, or fish, including the  
19 following:

20 a. Cakes, breads, Danish pastries, donuts, pastries,  
21 and pies.

22 b. Jam, jellies, and fruit preserves.

23 c. Candy.

24 d. Dried and dehydrated herbs, herb mixes,  
25 vegetables, or fruits.

26 e. Roasted coffee.

27 f. Dried baking mixes.

1                    g. Fermented or preserved vegetables or fruit that  
2                    do not result in the production of alcohol and that have an  
3                    acidity level allowed by the department.
