| 2 | Section 1. Section 34-21A-10 of the Code of Alabama |
| 3 | 1975, is amended to read as follows: |
| 4 | "§34-21A-10. |
| 5 | "(a) The licensing requirements of this chapter |
| 6 | shall not apply to owners of property for the purpose of |
| 7 | installing, cleaning, servicing, or maintaining an onsite |
| 8 | sewage system on their own property with a one-family or |
| 9 | two-family residence used as their primary residence so long |
| 10 | as the owners of the property with an onsite sewage system |
| 11 | complete all installation, cleaning, servicing, or maintenance |
| 12 | themselves, without help, at their primary residence. |
| 13 | "(b) The board shall not license or regulate any of |
| 14 | the following: |
| 15 | "(1) An individual or entity that distributes septic |
| 16 | tanks or conventional or engineered onsite sewage systems or |
| 17 | onsite wastewater systems. |
| 18 | "(2) An owner of multiple wastewater systems, or a |

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
