8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would require local boards of  
9 education to provide feminine hygiene products at  
10 certain schools under the board's jurisdiction.

12 A BILL  
13 TO BE ENTITLED  
14 AN ACT  
15

16 Relating to public K-12 education; to require local  
17 boards of education to have available feminine hygiene  
18 products in certain schools at no cost to students.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. (a) Commencing with the 2022-2023  
21 scholastic year, each local board of education shall have  
22 available, in each school building under the jurisdiction of  
23 the board, where any student in grades five through 12 is  
24 enrolled, at the request of a student for personal use and at  
25 no cost to students, feminine hygiene products.

26 (b) For the purposes of this section, feminine  
27 hygiene products are sanitary napkins and tampons.

1                   Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
2 first day of the third month following its passage and  
3 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
