8 SYNOPSIS: This bill makes a supplemental appropriation  
9 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama  
10 Institute for Deaf and Blind, Board of Trustees in  
11 the amount of \$3,500,000 for the fiscal year ending  
12 September 30, 2021; makes a supplemental  
13 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the  
14 Educational Television Commission in the amount of  
15 \$5,500,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
16 2021; makes a supplemental appropriation from the  
17 Education Trust Fund to the Marine Environmental  
18 Sciences Consortium in the amount of \$2,000,000 for  
19 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; makes a  
20 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust  
21 Fund to Tuskegee University in the amount of  
22 \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
23 2021; makes a supplemental appropriation from the

18 Stabilization Fund in the amount of \$75,000,000

20 September 30, 2021.

26 To make a supplemental appropriation from the  
27 Education Trust Fund to the Alabama Institute for Deaf and

1 Blind, Board of Trustees in the amount of \$3,500,000 for the  
2 fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental  
3 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Educational  
4 Television Commission in the amount of \$5,500,000 for the  
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental  
6 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the Marine  
7 Environmental Sciences Consortium in the amount of \$2,000,000  
8 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a  
9 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to  
10 Tuskegee University in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal  
11 year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental  
12 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to Athens State  
13 University in the amount of \$880,000 for the fiscal year  
14 ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental  
15 appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to the University  
16 of West Alabama in the amount of \$592,300 for the fiscal year

4 Commission on Higher Education in the amount of \$470,000 for  
5 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a  
6 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to  
7 the Alabama Historical Commission in the amount of \$275,000  
8 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a  
9 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to  
10 the Alabama Department of Archives and History in the amount  
11 of \$100,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to  
12 make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust  
13 Fund to the Innovation Fund in the amount of \$1,000,000 for  
14 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a  
15 supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust Fund to  
16 the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts in the amount  
17 of \$574,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to  
18 make a supplemental appropriation from the Education Trust  
19 Fund to the Education Trust Fund Advancement and Technology  
20 Fund in the amount of \$65,000,000 for the fiscal year ending  
21 September 30, 2021; to allow a temporary transfer from the  
22 Budget Stabilization Fund to the Education Trust Fund in the  
23 fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, under certain  
24 extraordinary conditions; and to make a transfer from the  
25 Education Trust Fund to the Budget Stabilization Fund in the  
26 amount of \$75,000,000 under certain conditions for the fiscal  
27 year ending September 30, 2021.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations  
3 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
4 \$3,500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama  
5 Institute for Deaf and Blind, Board of Trustees for the fiscal  
6 year ending September 30, 2021. Of this appropriation,  
7 \$1,000,000 shall be expended for demolition and an  
8 environmental study of ANG Decatur Property; and \$2,500,000  
9 shall be expended for the Independent Living Center at AIDB  
10 Talladega.

11 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations  
12 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
13 \$5,500,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Educational  
14 Television Commission for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
15 2021, for nonrecurring expenditures, including, but not  
16 limited to, transmitters and fiber optic network.

17 Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations  
18 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
19 \$2,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Marine  
20 Environmental Sciences Consortium for the fiscal year ending  
21 September 30, 2021, to assist with recovery efforts from  
22 damage caused by Hurricane Sally.

23 Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations  
24 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
25 \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Tuskegee  
26 University for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, for  
27 Armstrong Hall Laboratory improvements.

1           Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations  
2 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
3 \$880,000 from the Education Trust Fund to Athens State  
4 University, Board of Trustees for the fiscal year ending  
5 September 30, 2021, for one-time costs of HyFlex classrooms.

6           Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations  
7 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
8 \$592,300 from the Education Trust Fund to the University of  
9 West Alabama, Board of Trustees for the fiscal year ending  
10 September 30, 2021, for a campus-wide security system.

11           Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations  
12 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
13 \$900,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the University of  
14 South Alabama for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021,  
15 for the School of Marine and Environmental Sciences.

16           Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations  
17 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
18 \$175,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the University of  
19 North Alabama for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021,  
20 for a workforce development pilot project.

21           Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations  
22 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
23 \$2,545,718 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama  
24 Community College System for the fiscal year ending September  
25 30, 2021. Of this appropriation, \$315,718 shall be expended  
26 for the Drake State Community Technical College NASA Frontiers  
27 Project, \$230,000 shall be expended for the Wallace State

1 Community College-Hanceville Winston County Learning Center  
2 project, and \$2,000,000 shall be expended to establish new and  
3 to support current stand-alone LPN programs throughout the  
4 state.

5 Section 10. (a) In addition to all other  
6 appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby  
7 appropriated \$52,750,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the  
8 State Department of Education for the fiscal year ending  
9 September 30, 2021. Of this appropriation, \$50,000,000 shall  
10 be distributed to the TEAMS Fund established by House Bill  
11 537/Senate Bill 327 of the 2021 Regular Session of the  
12 Legislature or subsequent act of the Legislature for the  
13 purpose of implementing a new math and science teacher salary  
14 schedule; \$1,000,000 shall be expended for a marketing  
15 campaign for teachers; \$750,000 shall be expended for the  
16 National Board Certification of Teachers; and \$1,000,000 shall  
17 be expended for the Remote Learning Hub Pilot.

18 (b) The above appropriation for the Remote Learning  
19 Hub Pilot shall be used to pilot a dynamic and interactive  
20 remote learning model to deliver effective, highly engaging  
21 STEM education in regions of Alabama that struggle to reach  
22 desired student outcomes in math, science, and technology.  
23 Development and implementation of this innovative model shall  
24 be led by the National Math and Science Initiative (NMSI),  
25 working with a coalition of Alabama stakeholders, including  
26 the Alabama STEM Council. The State Superintendent of  
27 Education shall collaborate with NMSI to support this pilot



1 program to reimagine how STEM education is delivered,  
2 especially in hard-to-reach, high poverty, or traditionally  
3 underserved locations. The pilot program will offer STEM  
4 learning pathways for grades 6-12, focusing on Algebra  
5 preparedness and success in the project's first phase  
6 (2021-2022).

7 Section 11. In addition to all other appropriations  
8 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
9 \$470,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama  
10 Commission on Higher Education for the fiscal year ending  
11 September 30, 2021. Of this amount, \$270,000 shall be expended  
12 for the Best and Brightest STEM Pilot Program under the same  
13 terms and conditions as Act 2020-204; and \$200,000 shall be  
14 expended for the Trails Foundation and allocated as follows:  
15 \$100,000 for the Singing River Trail and \$100,000 for the  
16 Pinhoti River Trail.

17 Section 12. In addition to all other appropriations  
18 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
19 \$275,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama  
20 Historical Commission for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
21 2021, for one-time expenses for Fort Toulouse.

22 Section 13. In addition to all other appropriations  
23 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
24 \$100,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Alabama  
25 Department of Archives and History for the fiscal year ending  
26 September 30, 2021, for one-time expenses for the Civil Rights  
27 Voting Project.

1           Section 14. In addition to all other appropriations  
2 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
3 \$1,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Innovation  
4 Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, to be  
5 expended for the Innovation Corporation, subject to House Bill  
6 540 of the 2021 Regular Session being enacted into law.

7           Section 15. In addition to all other appropriations  
8 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
9 \$574,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Department of  
10 Examiners of Public Accounts for the fiscal year ending  
11 September 30, 2021, for continuation of the evaluation and  
12 reorganization study of the State Department of Education.

13           Section 16. In addition to all other appropriations  
14 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
15 \$65,000,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Education  
16 Trust Fund Advancement and Technology Fund for the fiscal year  
17 ending September 30, 2021, to be allocated in accordance with  
18 Section 29-9-4, Code of Alabama 1975.

19           Section 17. Notwithstanding the provisions of  
20 Section 29-9-6, Code of Alabama 1975, during the fiscal year  
21 ending September 30, 2021, the Finance Director may  
22 temporarily transfer funds from the Budget Stabilization Fund  
23 into the Education Trust Fund at any time during the fiscal  
24 year, if necessary, to alleviate cash flow problems resulting  
25 from changes to the due dates for the payment of income taxes.  
26 Any funds temporarily transferred pursuant to this section  
27 shall be repaid before September 30, 2021.

1                   Section 18. In addition to all other provisions of  
2 this act, if the Finance Director certifies in September 2021,  
3 that the ending balance in the Education Trust Fund for the  
4 fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, will exceed  
5 \$75,000,000, then \$75,000,000 shall be transferred to the  
6 Budget Stabilization Fund established by Section 29-9-4, Code  
7 of Alabama 1975.

8                   Section 19. All funds appropriated in this act not  
9 expended in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, shall  
10 not revert but shall be carried forward for the purpose  
11 appropriated.

12                   Section 20. This act shall become effective  
13 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
14 upon its otherwise becoming law.
