TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

To make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the Alabama Tourism Department in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the Board of Pardons and Paroles in the amount of \$14,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the Supreme Court in the amount of \$633,985 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the Office of

Information Technology in the amount of \$4,500,000 for the 1 2 fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State Board of Dietetics/Nutrition Fund 3 to the Alabama State Board of Examiners for 4 5 Dietetics/Nutrition Practice in the amount of \$150,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental 6 7 appropriation from the State General Fund to the Department of Public Health in the amount of \$9,200,000 for the fiscal year 8 ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental 9 10 appropriation from the State General Fund to the Judicial Inquiry Commission in the amount of \$460,000 for the fiscal 11 year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental 12 13 appropriation from the State General Fund to the Alabama Department of Forensic Sciences in the amount of \$304,000 for 14 15 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the 16 17 Alabama Department of Mental Health in the amount of 18 \$1,200,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to 19 make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund 20 to the Alabama Department of Veterans Affairs in the amount of 21 \$50,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make 22 a supplemental appropriation from the Litigation Support Fund to the Office of the Attorney General in the amount of 23 24 \$8,044,783 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to 25 make a supplemental appropriation of federal funds to the 26 Department of Economic and Community Affairs in the amount of an estimated \$12,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 27

30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation of any federal funds paid to the State from the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund that must be distributed to local governments to the Department of Finance for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation of available federal funds from the Alabama Homeowner Assistance Fund to the Department of Finance of an estimated \$125,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; and to amend Section 10 of Act 2020-168, the General Fund Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, regarding the appropriation and use of additional federal stimulus funds.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$1,000,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Tourism Department for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to be expended for the World Games.

Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$14,000,000 from the State General Fund to the Board of Pardons and Paroles for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021.

Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$633,985 from the State General Fund to the Supreme Court for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to be used for the updates to the case management and e-filing systems.

Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$4,500,000 from the State General Fund to the Office of Information Technology for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to be used for cybersecurity.

Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$150,000 from the State Board of Dietetics/Nutrition Fund to the Alabama State Board of Examiners for Dietetics/Nutrition Practice for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021.

Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$9,200,000 from the State General Fund to the Department of Public Health for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, of which \$7,500,000 shall be used for Coronavirus preparedness and response activities, \$1,200,000 shall be used for workforce development schools for in-demand medical professionals with the Huntsville Hospital Health System, and \$500,000 shall be used for one-time capital expenses for the USA Women's and Children's Hospital.

Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$460,000 from the State General Fund to the Judicial Inquiry Commission for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021.

Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$304,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Department

of Forensic Sciences for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2 2021 to be used for one-time capital outlay expenses.

Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$1,200,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Department of Mental Health to be used for one-time expenses for a crisis residential unit for civilly committed individuals in Region 1. Any amount of this appropriation remaining unexpended on September 30, 2021, shall be reappropriated for the same purpose for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021.

Section 10. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$50,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Department of Veterans Affairs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021.

Section 11. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$8,044,783 from the Litigation Support Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to establish a grant program to address opioid abuse prevention and treatment. Any amount of this appropriation remaining unexpended on September 30, 2021, shall be reappropriated to the Office for the same purpose for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021.

Section 12. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated an

estimated \$12,000,000 in federal funds to the Alabama

Department of Economic and Community Affairs for the fiscal

year ending September 30, 2021 for the Low-Income Household

Water Assistance Program established by the Consolidated

Appropriation Act, 2021, Pub.L. No. 116-260. Any amount of

this appropriation remaining unexpended on September 30, 2021,

shall be reappropriated to the Department for the same purpose

for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021.

Section 13. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated to the Department of Finance for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 any federal funds paid to the state from the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund established by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 that must be distributed to Nonentitlement Units of Local Government within 30 days after the state receives the funds pursuant to the requirements of the Act.

Section 14. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated an estimated \$125,000,000 in federal funds from the Alabama Homeowner Assistance Fund to the Department of Finance for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to be delegated through memorandum of agreement to the Alabama Housing Finance Authority for the purpose of administering the Homeowner Assistance Program established by Section 3206 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. Any amount of this appropriation remaining unexpended on September 30, 2021, shall be

reappropriated to the Department for the same purpose for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021.

Section 15. Section 10 of Act 2020-168, the General Fund Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, is hereby amended as follows:

"Section 10. (a) In addition to appropriations herein made, all gifts, grants, insurance proceeds, contributions, or entitlements, in excess of the amount carried in this act, including grants by the Congress of the United States, municipalities, or counties, to any department, division, board, bureau, commission, agency, institution, office, or officer of the State of Alabama are hereby appropriated and, in the event the same are recurring, are reappropriated to such department, division, board, bureau, commission, agency, institution, office, or officer to be used only for the purpose or purposes for which the grant or contribution was or shall be made. Further, all state, county, municipal, and educational entities are authorized to disburse such sums as deemed necessary by mutual agreement among said entities, the State of Alabama, and the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts to partially defray the cost of auditing services performed by said agency. All such sums are hereby appropriated and reappropriated if necessary to the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts for audit services, to be expended through the fund established by Section 41-5A-22, Code of Alabama 1975.

"(b) Provided, however, this section shall not apply to the state Coronavirus Relief Fund amounts provided by the Congress of the United States to the State of Alabama from the Coronavirus, Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (P.L. 116-136), except for any balance of such funds remaining from the appropriation made for Fiscal Year 2020 that remain unspent at the end of Fiscal Year 2020 for expenditures related to the coronavirus pandemic. The Department of Finance shall report on a monthly basis all expenditures made from these funds in a manner publicly accessible on the Governor's Coronavirus Disease 2019 News and Resources webpage.

"(c) This section shall also not apply to any additional federal stimulus funds provided to the state to offset revenue losses or for purposes directly related to the coronavirus pandemic, other than additional funds provided for existing federal programs. Any Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Funds or Coronavirus Capital Projects Funds received by the State of Alabama from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, shall be appropriated by and through one or more independent supplemental appropriation bills. Any amount of Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Funds used to replace lost revenues shall be based upon estimates of lost revenues provided by the Director of Finance and the Deputy Director of the Legislative Services Agency, Fiscal Division and a plan approved by the Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Chair of each budget committee of the Alabama Legislature."

Section 16. This act shall become effective

immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or

upon its otherwise becoming law.
