23 \$14,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to
24 make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund
25 to the Supreme Court in the amount of \$633,985 for the fiscal
26 year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental
27 appropriation from the State General Fund to the Office of

1 Information Technology in the amount of \$4,500,000 for the
2 fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental
3 appropriation from the State Board of Dietetics/Nutrition Fund
4 to the Alabama State Board of Examiners for
5 Dietetics/Nutrition Practice in the amount of \$150,000 for the
6 fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental
7 appropriation from the State General Fund to the Department of
8 Public Health in the amount of \$9,200,000 for the fiscal year

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

13 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations
14 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
15 \$1,000,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Tourism
16 Department for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to be
17 expended for the World Games.

18 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations
19 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
20 \$14,000,000 from the State General Fund to the Board of
21 Pardons and Paroles for the fiscal year ending September 30,
22 2021.

23 Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations
24 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
25 \$633,985 from the State General Fund to the Supreme Court for
26 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to be used for the
27 updates to the case management and e-filing systems.

1 Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations
2 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
3 \$4,500,000 from the State General Fund to the Office of
4 Information Technology for the fiscal year ending September
5 30, 2021 to be used for cybersecurity.

6 Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations
7 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
8 \$150,000 from the State Board of Dietetics/Nutrition Fund to
9 the Alabama State Board of Examiners for Dietetics/Nutrition
10 Practice for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021.

11 Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations
12 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
13 \$9,200,000 from the State General Fund to the Department of
14 Public Health for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021,
15 of which \$7,500,000 shall be used for Coronavirus preparedness
16 and response activities, \$1,200,000 shall be used for
17 workforce development schools for in-demand medical
18 professionals with the Huntsville Hospital Health System, and
19 \$500,000 shall be used for one-time capital expenses for the
20 USA Women's and Children's Hospital.

21 Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations
22 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
23 \$460,000 from the State General Fund to the Judicial Inquiry
24 Commission for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021.

25 Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations
26 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
27 \$304,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Department

1 of Forensic Sciences for the fiscal year ending September 30,
2 2021 to be used for one-time capital outlay expenses.

3 Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations
4 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
5 \$1,200,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama
6 Department of Mental Health to be used for one-time expenses
7 for a crisis residential unit for civilly committed
8 individuals in Region 1. Any amount of this appropriation
9 remaining unexpended on September 30, 2021, shall be
10 reappropriated for the same purpose for the fiscal year
11 beginning October 1, 2021.

12 Section 10. In addition to all other appropriations
13 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
14 \$50,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Department
15 of Veterans Affairs for the fiscal year ending September 30,
16 2021.

17 Section 11. In addition to all other appropriations
18 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
19 \$8,044,783 from the Litigation Support Fund to the Office of
20 the Attorney General for the fiscal year ending September 30,
21 2021 to establish a grant program to address opioid abuse
22 prevention and treatment. Any amount of this appropriation
23 remaining unexpended on September 30, 2021, shall be
24 reappropriated to the Office for the same purpose for the
25 fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021.

26 Section 12. In addition to all other appropriations
27 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated an

1 estimated \$12,000,000 in federal funds to the Alabama
2 Department of Economic and Community Affairs for the fiscal
3 year ending September 30, 2021 for the Low-Income Household
4 Water Assistance Program established by the Consolidated
5 Appropriation Act, 2021, Pub.L. No. 116-260. Any amount of
6 this appropriation remaining unexpended on September 30, 2021,
7 shall be reappropriated to the Department for the same purpose
8 for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021.

9 Section 13. In addition to all other appropriations
10 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated to
11 the Department of Finance for the fiscal year ending September
12 30, 2021 any federal funds paid to the state from the
13 Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund established by the
14 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 that must be distributed to
15 Nonentitlement Units of Local Government within 30 days after
16 the state receives the funds pursuant to the requirements of
17 the Act.

18 Section 14. In addition to all other appropriations
19 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated an
20 estimated \$125,000,000 in federal funds from the Alabama
21 Homeowner Assistance Fund to the Department of Finance for the
22 fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to be delegated through
23 memorandum of agreement to the Alabama Housing Finance
24 Authority for the purpose of administering the Homeowner
25 Assistance Program established by Section 3206 of the American
26 Rescue Plan Act of 2021. Any amount of this appropriation
27 remaining unexpended on September 30, 2021, shall be

1 reappropriated to the Department for the same purpose for the
2 fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021.

3 Section 15. Section 10 of Act 2020-168, the General
4 Fund Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September
5 30, 2021, is hereby amended as follows:

6 "Section 10. (a) In addition to appropriations
7 herein made, all gifts, grants, insurance proceeds,
8 contributions, or entitlements, in excess of the amount
9 carried in this act, including grants by the Congress of the
10 United States, municipalities, or counties, to any department,
11 division, board, bureau, commission, agency, institution,
12 office, or officer of the State of Alabama are hereby
13 appropriated and, in the event the same are recurring, are
14 reappropriated to such department, division, board, bureau,
15 commission, agency, institution, office, or officer to be used
16 only for the purpose or purposes for which the grant or
17 contribution was or shall be made. Further, all state, county,
18 municipal, and educational entities are authorized to disburse
19 such sums as deemed necessary by mutual agreement among said
20 entities, the State of Alabama, and the Department of
21 Examiners of Public Accounts to partially defray the cost of
22 auditing services performed by said agency. All such sums are
23 hereby appropriated and reappropriated if necessary to the
24 Department of Examiners of Public Accounts for audit services,
25 to be expended through the fund established by Section
26 41-5A-22, Code of Alabama 1975.

1 "(b) Provided, however, this section shall not apply
2 to the state Coronavirus Relief Fund amounts provided by the
3 Congress of the United States to the State of Alabama from the
4 Coronavirus, Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act
5 (P.L. 116-136), except for any balance of such funds remaining
6 from the appropriation made for Fiscal Year 2020 that remain
7 unspent at the end of Fiscal Year 2020 for expenditures
8 related to the coronavirus pandemic. The Department of Finance
9 shall report on a monthly basis all expenditures made from
10 these funds in a manner publicly accessible on the Governor's
11 Coronavirus Disease 2019 News and Resources webpage.

12 "(c) This section shall also not apply to any
13 additional federal stimulus funds provided to the state to
14 offset revenue losses or for purposes directly related to the
15 coronavirus pandemic, other than additional funds provided for
16 existing federal programs. Any Coronavirus State Fiscal
17 Recovery Funds or Coronavirus Capital Projects Funds received
18 by the State of Alabama from the American Rescue Plan Act of
19 2021, shall be appropriated by and through one or more
20 independent supplemental appropriation bills. Any amount of
21 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Funds used to replace lost
22 revenues shall be based upon estimates of lost revenues
23 provided by the Director of Finance and the Deputy Director of
24 the Legislative Services Agency, Fiscal Division and a plan
25 approved by the Governor, Speaker of the House of
26 Representatives, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the
27 Chair of each budget committee of the Alabama Legislature."

1 Section 16. This act shall become effective
2 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
3 upon its otherwise becoming law.
