15	Section 1. Section 27-13-3, Code of Alabama 1975, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	"§27-13-3.
18	"(a) The commissioner shall have authority to may
19	require any regulated insurer engaged in any of the businesses
20	in Alabama as enumerated in this article chapter to file with
21	the department any data or information required or necessary
22	in the performance of the duties of the commissioner, said the
23	data or information to be filed in $\frac{\text{such}}{\text{the}}$ manner and on $\frac{\text{such}}{\text{the}}$
24	forms as may be prescribed by $\frac{1}{2}$ the commissioner.
25	"(b) The records of the commissioner and insurance
26	filings in the commissioner's office submitted in accordance
27	with this chapter shall be open to public inspection, except

Τ	as otherwise provided by this title or where the records and
2	insurance filings are considered to be confidential as
3	commercially valuable trade secrets under Chapter 27 of Title
4	8. The commissioner may not release the confidential
5	information except by court order. The confidential
6	information shall be submitted under separate cover and
7	clearly state the desires of the party filing the information
8	as to its confidentiality. The confidential information shall
9	be maintained by the commissioner separate and distinct from
10	all records available for public inspection. If the
11	commissioner receives a court order to release the
12	confidential information, the commissioner shall give notice
13	of not less than 10 business days to the party that filed the
14	confidential information before releasing the information."
15	Section 2. This act shall become effective
16	immediately following its passage and approval by the
17	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
