26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. A church, temple, synagogue, mosque, or other religious organization, and any congregation thereof, is exempt from any emergency order, rule, regulation, or other requirement adopted or otherwise made during the existence of a state of emergency, including a state of public health emergency or a state technological emergency, proclaimed pursuant to Article 1, Chapter 9, Title 31, Code of Alabama 1975, the Alabama Emergency Management Act of 1955, to the extent the emergency order, rule, regulation, or other requirement imposes an undue burden on the religious organization's free exercise of religion.

Section 2. This act shall become effective

immediately following its passage and approval by the

Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
