SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the Public School and College Authority may use bond proceeds to pay for the cost of constructing, altering, improving, and equipping buildings and other facilities for public educational purposes in the state.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to education; to provide that the Public School and College Authority may use bond proceeds for construction, alterations, improvements, and equipment for public educational purposes at the Dauphin Island Sea Lab.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. The Public School and College Authority
3 may use proceeds from the sale of bonds issued by the
4 authority for the purpose of paying for the cost of
5 constructing, altering, improving, and equipping buildings and
6 other facilities of the Dauphin Island Sea Lab for public
7 educational purposes.

8 Section 2. This act shall become effective
9 immediately following its passage and approval by the
10 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
