11 "(2) If the board of registrars or Secretary of
12 State determines from the change-of-address information that a
13 registered voter has moved to a different residence address
14 that is under the jurisdiction of a different board of
15 registrars or to a residence address outside of the state, the
16 Secretary of State or board of registrars board of registrars
17 or Secretary of State, within 90 days after identifying the
18 potential change, shall send the voter a notice of the change
19 by forwardable mail along with a postage prepaid,
20 pre-addressed return card on which the registered voter may
21 verify or correct his or her current address information. The
22 notice shall include both of the following:

23 "a. A statement informing the voter that if the
24 pre-addressed card is not returned within the time specified
25 in the notice, the voter will be permitted to vote in that
26 same jurisdiction during the period from the date the notice
27 was mailed and ending on the day after the date of the second

1 general election for federal office, provided the voter
2 completes a voter registration update form. If the voter does
3 not update his or her voter registration record or vote during
4 the period ending on the day after the date of the second
5 general election for federal office, the voter's name shall be
6 removed from the list of eligible voters.

7 "b. Information concerning how the voter may
8 continue his or her eligibility to vote in another
9 jurisdiction if the voter has changed his or her residence to
10 an address outside of the jurisdiction of the board of
11 registrars under which he or she is then registered.

13 "(c) The board of registrars or Secretary of State
14 shall record and maintain in the statewide voter registration
15 database the dates on which the ~~nonforwardable~~ notice ~~was~~ is
16 mailed to a registered voter and the card is subsequently
17 returned to the board ~~and the date on which the forwardable~~
18 notice ~~was mailed to~~ by the registered voter.

19 ~~"(b)(d) The boards~~ board of registrars shall update
20 the ~~voter list for the county~~ statewide voter registration
21 database using the information reported to the board by the
22 registered voters on the ~~address confirmation~~ prepaid,
23 pre-addressed return cards provided for in ~~subsection (a)~~ this
24 section.

25 "(e) If the registered voter does not respond to the
26 forwardable notice ~~on which the registered voter may confirm~~
27 his or her address provided in this section within 90 days of

1 the date on which the notice was mailed or if the forwardable
2 notice is returned to the board of registrars as
3 undeliverable, the ~~boards~~ board of registrars or its agent
4 shall ~~place the name of the registered voter on the inactive~~
5 ~~list of registered voters and in a suspense file in the office~~
6 ~~of the board. The suspense file shall contain all of the~~
7 ~~following information:~~ change the status of the voter to
8 inactive and indicate in the statewide voter registration
9 database the date the change is recorded and that the voter
10 did not respond to the mailing or that the mailing was
11 returned as undeliverable, in a manner provided by rule by the
12 Secretary of State.

21 ~~vote or appear to vote in one of the next two federal~~

24 ~~"(d)(f)~~ (f) The names of persons to be removed from the
25 list of registered voters pursuant to this section shall be
26 published in accordance with Section 17-4-10.

1 "(g) The Secretary of State may adopt rules as
2 necessary to implement this section.

3 "(h) The Secretary of State may act as an agent for
4 the boards of registrars in implementing this section. a board
5 of registrars, only upon receiving the written consent of the
6 county commission, in implementing this section.

7 "§17-4-31.

8 "The state shall reimburse each county commission
9 for all the postage costs associated with voter lists
10 maintenance activities provided for in Section 17-4-30 and
11 ~~one-fourth~~ one-half of the cost of the publication of the
12 names of ~~persons~~ individuals to be removed from the list of
13 registered voters as required in Section 17-4-10. The
14 reimbursement shall be made from the Election Expenses Account
15 in the State Treasury upon approval by the Secretary of State
16 on warrants drawn by the state Comptroller."

17 Section 2. This act shall become effective
18 immediately following its passage and approval by the
19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
