SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the Alabama Board of Registration for Foresters may not hold more than one special meeting in any one calendar month.

This bill would allow special meetings to be called in accordance with the bylaws of the board.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Board of Registration for Foresters; to amend Section 34-12-34 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to allow the board to call special meetings in accordance with its bylaws.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 34-12-34, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§34-12-34.

"The members of the board shall be named and appointed by the Governor within 60 days after September 13,

1 1957. The board shall hold a meeting within 30 days after its
2 members are first appointed and thereafter shall hold at least
3 two regular meetings each year. Special meetings shall be held
4 at ~~such~~ the time and place as the bylaws of the board may
5 provide, ~~provided, that not more than one meeting may be held~~
6 ~~in any one calendar month.~~ Notice of all meetings shall be
7 given in ~~such~~ the manner as the bylaws may provide. The board
8 shall elect or appoint annually the following officers: A
9 chairman, vice-chairman, and a secretary, who shall each be
10 members of the board. A quorum of the board shall consist of
11 not less than three voting members."

12 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
13 first day of the third month following its passage and
14 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
