16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
17	Section 1. On and after the effective date of this
18	act, any municipality within Dale County may contract for
19	police services with the sheriff of the county. The contract
20	may include the enforcement by the sheriff and his or her duly
21	commissioned deputies of all laws within the corporate limits
22	and police jurisdiction of the municipality including
23	municipal ordinances and the arrest or citation of any
24	offenders as if the sheriff and his or her deputies were duly
25	constituted police officers of the municipality.
26	Section 2. A municipality entering into a contract
27	with the sheriff for police services shall pay to the county

treasury a sum sufficient to provide the necessary manpower and equipment as mutually agreed upon by the municipal governing body, the sheriff of the county, and the county commission.

- Section 3. The county governing body may receive from the municipality within the county money for police services and may expend funds for police services in the contracting municipality, including the police jurisdiction of the municipality.
 - Section 4. Each contract between the sheriff and the contracting municipality shall be with the consent and approval of the sheriff and the county commission.
 - Section 5. The sheriff and his or her duly commissioned deputies shall retain the legal and constitutional immunity afforded to each of them by law.
- Section 6. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.
- Section 7. The provisions of this act are severable.

 If any part of this act is declared invalid or

 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part

 which remains.
- Section 8. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
