"(41) (39) Any other local or regional historical society duly recognized by the commission which may exist or which may be created subsequent to August 19, 1966.

- "(b) Said The advisory board shall meet annually at a place to be designated by the commission and shall serve without compensation. The board shall advise the commission on matters relating to the historic and architectural assets of the State of Alabama and assist the commission in compiling and maintaining an inventory of such assets and in carrying out all of its various duties.
- "(c) There may further be added to the advisory board by the commission such other civic, charitable, and patriotic organizations as it may from time to time deem to be to the best interest of the commission."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
