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To make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the Alabama Tourism Department in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the Board of Pardons and Paroles in the amount of \$16,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the Supreme Court in the amount of \$633,985 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the Office of Information Technology in the amount of \$4,500,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State Board of Dietetics/Nutrition Fund to the Alabama State Board of Examiners for Dietetics/Nutrition Practice in the amount of \$150,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the Department of Public Health in the amount of \$8,700,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the Judicial

Inquiry Commission in the amount of \$460,000 for the fiscal 1 2 year ending September 30, 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund to the Alabama 3 Department of Forensic Sciences in the amount of \$304,000 for 4 5 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to make a supplemental appropriation of federal funds to the Department 6 7 of Economic and Community Affairs in the amount of an estimated \$12,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 8 9 2021; to make a supplemental appropriation of any federal 10 funds paid to the State from the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund that must be distributed to local governments to 11 the Department of Finance for the fiscal year ending September 12 13 30, 2021; and to amend Section 10 of Act 2020-168, the General Fund Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September 14 15 30, 2021, regarding the appropriation and use of additional 16 federal stimulus funds.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

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Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$1,000,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Tourism Department for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to be expended for the World Games.

Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$16,000,000 from the State General Fund to the Board of Pardons and Paroles for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021.

Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$633,985 from the State General Fund to the Supreme Court for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to be used for the updates to the case management and e-filing systems.

Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$4,500,000 from the State General Fund to the Office of Information Technology for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 to be used for cybersecurity.

Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$150,000 from the State Board of Dietetics/Nutrition Fund to the Alabama State Board of Examiners for Dietetics/Nutrition Practice for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021.

Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$8,700,000 from the State General Fund to the Department of Public Health for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021, of which \$7,500,000 shall be used for Coronavirus preparedness and response activities, and \$1,200,000 shall be used for workforce development schools for in-demand medical professionals with the Huntsville Hospital Health System.

Section 7. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$460,000 from the State General Fund to the Judicial Inquiry Commission for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021.

1 Section 8. In addition to all other appropriations 2 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$304,000 from the State General Fund to the Alabama Department 3 of Forensic Sciences to be used for one-time capital outlay 4 5 expenses. Section 9. In addition to all other appropriations 6 7 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated an 8 estimated \$12,000,000 in federal funds to the Alabama 9 Department of Economic and Community Affairs for the fiscal 10 year ending September 30, 2021 for the Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program established by the Consolidated 11 Appropriation Act, 2021, Pub.L. No. 116-260. Any amount of 12 13 this appropriation remaining unexpended on September 30, 2021, 14 shall be reappropriated to the Department for the same purpose 15 for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021. Section 10. In addition to all other appropriations 16 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated to 17 18 the Department of Finance for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 any federal funds paid to the state from the 19 20 Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund established by the 21 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 that must be distributed to 22 Nonentitlement Units of Local Government within 30 days after 23 the state receives the funds pursuant to the requirements of 24 the Act. 25 Section 11. Section 10 of Act 2020-168, the General Fund Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September 26 30, 2021, is hereby amended as follows: 27

1	"Section 10. (a) In addition to appropriations
2	herein made, all gifts, grants, insurance proceeds,
3	contributions, or entitlements, in excess of the amount
4	carried in this act, including grants by the Congress of the
5	United States, municipalities, or counties, to any department,
6	division, board, bureau, commission, agency, institution,
7	office, or officer of the State of Alabama are hereby
8	appropriated and, in the event the same are recurring, are
9	reappropriated to such department, division, board, bureau,
10	commission, agency, institution, office, or officer to be used
11	only for the purpose or purposes for which the grant or
12	contribution was or shall be made. Further, all state, county,
13	municipal, and educational entities are authorized to disburse
14	such sums as deemed necessary by mutual agreement among said
15	entities, the State of Alabama, and the Department of
16	Examiners of Public Accounts to partially defray the cost of
17	auditing services performed by said agency. All such sums are
18	hereby appropriated and reappropriated if necessary to the
19	Department of Examiners of Public Accounts for audit services,
20	to be expended through the fund established by Section
21	41-5A-22, Code of Alabama 1975.
22	(b) Provided, however, this section shall not apply
23	to the state Coronavirus Relief Fund amounts provided by the
24	Congress of the United States to the State of Alabama from the
25	Coronavirus, Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act
26	(P.L. 116-136), except for any balance of such funds remaining
27	from the appropriation made for Fiscal Year 2020 that remain

1	unspent at the end of Fiscal Year 2020 for expenditures
2	related to the coronavirus pandemic. The Department of Finance
3	shall report on a monthly basis all expenditures made from
4	these funds in a manner publicly accessible on the Governor's
5	Coronavirus Disease 2019 News and Resources webpage.
6	(c) This section shall also not apply to any
7	additional federal stimulus funds provided to the state to
8	offset revenue losses or for purposes directly related to the
9	coronavirus pandemic, other than additional funds provided for
10	existing federal programs. Any Coronavirus State Fiscal
11	Recovery Funds received by the State of Alabama from the
12	American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, shall be appropriated by and
13	through one or more independent supplemental appropriation
14	bills. Any amount of Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Funds
15	used to replace lost revenues shall be based upon estimates of
16	lost revenues provided by the Director of Finance and the
17	Deputy Director of the Legislative Services Agency, Fiscal
18	Division and a plan approved by the Governor, Speaker of the
19	House of Representatives, President Pro Tempore of the Senate,
20	and the Chair of each budget committee of the Alabama
21	Legislature."
22	Section 12. This act shall become effective
23	immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
24	upon its otherwise becoming law.
