13 Relating to Fayette County; to provide law
14 enforcement powers for a community corrections officer in
15 certain circumstances.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Upon successfully completing the minimum
18 standards of training and other requirements for law
19 enforcement officers of the Peace Officers' Standards and
20 Training Commission, a community corrections officer employed
21 by the Community Punishment and Corrections Authority of the
22 24th Judicial Circuit, operating in Fayette County, shall have
23 the same law enforcement powers, including powers of arrest,
24 as granted to law enforcement officers of this state.

25 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
26 first day of the third month following its passage and
27 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
