Under existing law, the state imposes sales 8 SYNOPSIS: and use taxes upon certain persons, firms, or 9 10 corporations. The amount of the taxes ranges from 11 one and one-half to four percent of the gross 12 proceeds of the sale or consumption of various 13 types of tangible personal property. The state also 14 imposes a sales tax on the operation of places of amusement or entertainment. Counties and 15 16 municipalities impose various additional sales and 17 use taxes. Certain entities are exempted from 18 state, county, or local sales and use taxes. 19 This bill would exempt the Birmingham

20Holocaust Education Center from paying any state,21county, and municipal sales and use taxes.22

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

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To exempt the Birmingham Holocaust Education Center from the payment of all state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. (a) The Birmingham Holocaust Education 6 Center is exempt from paying any state, county, and municipal 7 sales and use taxes associated with any and all capital 8 expenditures.

9 (b) The exemption provided pursuant to subsection 10 (a) shall be available until December 31, 2023.

(c) The Birmingham Holocaust Education Center shall report annually to the Department of Revenue on the sales for which the exemption is granted. The Department of Revenue shall prescribe the format of such annual report.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
