Section 2. The existence and functioning of the 9 Alabama Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and 10 Audiology, created and functioning pursuant to Sections 34-28A-1 to 34-28A-44, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is 11 12 continued, and those code sections are expressly preserved 13 until October 1, 2025. 14 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the 15 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in Sections 1 and 2. 16

Section 4. This act shall become effective

immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or

its otherwise becoming law.
