13	would be deposited into a fund managed by the Alabama Joint
14	Fire Council and used for the purpose of expanding and
15	maintaining the Alabama Firefighter Memorial located in
16	Tuscaloosa, and that the other 50 cents of each dollar
17	collected would be distributed to the Alabama Fire College to
18	be used for training expenses associated with the Firefighter
19	Peer Support program.
20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. Sections 32-6-271 and 32-6-280, Code of
22	Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:
23	"§32-6-271.
24	"(a) A firefighter may, upon application and subject
25	to the provisions of this division, may be issued a
26	distinctive motor vehicle license plate as identification as a
27	firefighter. In addition to the proper numbers, words, and

insignias used on the standard license plate issued for motor vehicles, the distinctive plates so issued firefighters shall bear a red Maltese cross emblem on each side to the left and right of the regular tag numbers. The words "Fire Fighter" should be centered at the bottom of the license plate.

"(b) In addition to any other fees provided for by 6 7 law, an annual additional fee of twenty-five cents (\$.25) one 8 dollar (\$1.00) is added to the cost of the firefighter 9 distinctive license plate provided for in this division, 10 effective January 1, 2022. The annual additional fee collected pursuant to this section shall be distributed by each 11 licensing official to the state Comptroller. The state 12 13 Comptroller shall distribute the net proceeds monthly as 14 follows:

"(a) As used in this section, the following termsshall have the following meanings:

"(1) Professional firefighter means a paid member of
a paid or part-paid fire department of a city, town, county,
or other subdivision of the state, including the chief,

1 assistant chief, warden, engineer, captain, firemen, and all 2 other officers and employees of the department who actually 3 engage in fire fighting or rendering first aid at the scene of 4 an accident.

5 "(2) Retired professional firefighter means a 6 retired member of a paid or part-paid fire department of a 7 city, town, county, or other subdivision of the state, including the chief, assistant chief, warden, engineer, 8 9 captain, firemen, and all other officers and employees of the 10 department who actually engaged in fire fighting or rendering first aid at the scene of an accident. Notwithstanding any 11 other provision of this division, retired professional 12 13 firefighter includes a retired professional firefighter who is a resident of this state and who has retired from a 14 15 professional fire department in another state and otherwise meets the requirements of this section. 16

"(b)(1) Notwithstanding Sections 32-6-64, 32-6-67, 17 18 and 32-6-68, a retired professional firefighter, upon application and subject to the provisions of this section, may 19 20 be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license plate as 21 identification as a retired professional firefighter, and a professional firefighter, upon application and subject to the 22 provisions of this section, may be issued a distinctive motor 23 24 vehicle license plate as identification as a professional 25 firefighter.

"(2) In addition to the proper numbers, words, and
insignias used on the standard license plate issued for motor

1 vehicles, the distinctive plates so issued for a retired 2 professional firefighter shall have a design created by the state association of professional firefighters in coordination 3 with the Mobile Retired Firefighters and Paramedics 4 5 Association and the Tuscaloosa Retired Firefighters 6 Association, and the distinctive license plate so issued for a 7 professional firefighter shall have a design created by the state association of professional firefighters. 8

9 "(c)(1) The distinctive license plates provided 10 herein shall be approved by the Commissioner of Revenue and 11 shall be issued through the judge of probate, license 12 commissioner, or other license issuing official of the several 13 counties of the state in the same manner as are other motor 14 vehicle license plates and the officers shall be entitled to 15 their regular fees for the service.

16 "(2) By December 1 of each year, the Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education Commission shall submit to 17 18 the judge of probate, the license commissioner, or other license issuing official of each county a list of eligible 19 20 retired professional firefighters retired from paid or 21 part-paid fire departments under this section. The Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education Commission 22 23 shall also add to the list any retired professional 24 firefighter retired from a paid or part-paid fire department 25 in another state who submits proof to the commission of 26 eligibility pursuant to this division. The Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education Commission shall also submit 27

to the judge of probate, the license commissioner, or other license issuing official of each county a list of eligible professional firefighters from paid or part-paid fire departments.

5 "(3) Any person who joins a paid or part-paid fire department after December 1 of any year or any person who is 6 7 omitted from the list prepared as described above in 8 subdivision (2) may obtain a distinctive license plate by 9 presenting to the license issuing official proof of his or her 10 membership in a paid or part-paid fire department by means of a certificate signed by the chief of the department on a form 11 prescribed by the Firefighters' Personnel Standards and 12 13 Education Commission.

"(4) Upon the initial application for a retired 14 15 professional firefighter distinctive license plate under this section, an applicant for a distinctive plate provided herein 16 17 in this section shall present to the judge of probate, the 18 license commissioner, or other license issuing official of the county, proof of his or her retirement from a fire department 19 20 that is included on the list provided by the Firefighters' 21 Personnel Standards and Education Commission. Proof of the 22 person's retirement from a fire department included on the list from the Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education 23 24 Commission is not required for renewal of the distinctive 25 plate.

26 "(5) Upon the applicant submitting proof of his or27 her identification, the professional firefighter shall be

issued the requested number of distinctive license plates upon the payment of the regular fee for license plates, as provided by law, but shall not be required to pay the three dollar (\$3) fee.

5 "(6) Upon the applicant submitting proof of his or 6 her identification, the retired professional firefighter shall 7 be issued the requested number of distinctive license plates 8 upon the payment of the regular license fee for plates, as 9 provided by law, but shall not be required to pay the three 10 dollar (\$3) fee.

"(7) The distinctive license plates so issued shall 11 12 be used only upon and for personally owned, private passenger 13 vehicles, to include station wagons and pick-up trucks, registered in the name of the retired professional firefighter 14 15 or professional firefighter making application therefor, and when so issued to the applicant shall be used upon the vehicle 16 for which issued in lieu of the standard license plates 17 normally issued for the vehicle. 18

"(8) In addition to any other fees provided for by 19 20 law, an annual additional fee of twenty-five cents (\$.25) one 21 dollar (\$1.00) is added to the cost of the retired professional firefighter and the professional firefighter 22 23 distinctive license plates provided for in this division. The 24 annual additional fee collected pursuant to this section shall 25 be, effective January 1, 2022. The annual additional fee 26 collected pursuant to this section shall be distributed by each licensing official to the state Comptroller. The state 27

1 <u>Comptroller shall distribute the net proceeds monthly as</u>
2 <u>follows:</u>

3 "<u>a. Fifty cents (\$.50) shall be</u> deposited into a
4 fund managed by the Alabama Joint Fire Council and shall be
5 used for the purpose of expanding and maintaining the Alabama
6 Firefighter Memorial located in Tuscaloosa.

7 "b. Fifty cents (\$.50) shall be distributed to the
8 Alabama Fire College to be used for training expenses
9 associated with the Firefighter Peer Support Program.

10 "(9) Anyone who is proven to have either falsely
11 obtained or certified an individual to obtain a distinctive
12 retired professional firefighter license plate or a
13 distinctive professional firefighter license plate shall be
14 guilty of a Class C misdemeanor, and upon conviction, shall be
15 punished according to law.

16 "(d) Retired professional firefighters distinctive 17 license plates as provided by this section shall be prepared 18 and furnished for the licensing year commencing January 1, 2012, and thereafter as is provided by law for the issuance of 19 20 other license plates. Professional firefighters distinctive 21 license plates as provided by this section shall be prepared 22 and furnished for the licensing year commencing January 1, 2016, and thereafter as is provided by law for the issuance of 23 24 other license plates.

"(e) The Department of Revenue may promulgate adopt
 any rules necessary to administer this section."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
 first day of the third month following its passage and
 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
