Section 1. Section 40-10-15, Code of Alabama 1975,
is amended to read as follows:

10 "<u>(a)</u> Such sales <u>Sales conducted pursuant to this</u> 11 <u>article</u> shall be made <u>in front of the door of on the premises</u> 12 <u>of or within</u> the courthouse <u>or courthouse annex</u> of the county 13 at public outery <u>auction</u>, to the highest bidder for cash, 14 between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., and shall 15 continue from day to day until all the real estate embraced in 16 the decree has been sold.

17 "(b) The judge of probate, or his or her designee, 18 must shall attend such the sales and make a record thereof of 19 the sales. in a book to be kept by him in his office for that 20 purpose, in which he shall describe The judge of probate, or 21 his or her designee, shall include all of the following in the 22 record:

12 Section 2. This act is remedial and curative and 13 shall be retroactive to validate any prior sale of land for 14 taxes conducted in accordance with this act.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
