| 19 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: |
| 20 | Section 1. Section 45-17-91.23, Code of Alabama |
| 21 | 1975, is amended to read as follows: |
| 22 | "§45-17-91.23. |
| 23 | "(a) There is created the Shoals Economic |
| 24 | Development Fund, which shall be a special or trust fund or |
| 25 | account of the committee, and which shall be administered in |
| 26 | accordance with this subpart. |
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1 "(b)(1) The authority may, at any time and from time 2 to time, request that the committee authorize and approve the 3 expenditure or appropriation of moneys on deposit in the 4 Shoals Economic Development Fund, but solely for purposes 5 authorized in subsection (c). Any such request may specify 6 that such moneys shall be expended by, or appropriated 7 directly or indirectly to, any of the following:

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"a. The authority itself.

9 "b. Either of the counties, or any city or town 10 located, in whole or in part, in either of the counties.

"c. Any public corporation that has been organized 11 with the approval or consent of any one or more of the 12 13 counties, the municipalities, or any other city or town in either of the counties, and that operates for the purpose, 14 15 among others, of supporting the establishment and promotion of business and industry or the development of trade and 16 commerce, including, without limiting the generality of the 17 18 foregoing, any county or municipal industrial development board, industrial development authority, or port authority. 19

20 "(2) Every such recipient shall be liable for any 21 misuse of such moneys to the extent provided by the law or 22 laws under which it was created or organized, or as otherwise provided by law. The authority may, if and to the extent it is 23 24 otherwise authorized by law to do so, expend any moneys so 25 appropriated to it out of the Shoals Economic Development Fund 26 without any further consent or other action on the part of the 27 committee.

"(c) Subject to succeeding provisions of this 1 2 subpart, including particularly, but without limitation, those provisions hereof respecting the investment of moneys held in 3 and forming a part of the Shoals Economic Development Fund, 4 5 and the management, use, and disposition of other properties, whether real or personal, tangible or intangible, contributed 6 7 to such fund, all moneys held in and forming a part of the Shoals Economic Development Fund, whether such moneys may be 8 characterized as either principal or income of such fund, may 9 10 be expended or appropriated, and all other properties contributed to such fund may be used, only for the following 11 12 purposes:

13 "(1) To induce the location, within either of the 14 counties or any city or town therein, of (i) new 15 manufacturing, industrial, and research enterprises, (ii) new commercial enterprises for storing, warehousing, or 16 17 distributing any products of agriculture or industry, 18 including, without limitation, warehouse or distribution centers owned or utilized by commercial or retail enterprises 19 20 existing in either of the counties or any city or town 21 therein, (iii) new enterprises for maintaining, repairing, or 22 restoring transportation and communications machinery and equipment of any kind including, without limitation, motor 23 24 vehicles and vehicles for air or water transport of every 25 description, and (iv) new facilities suitable for use by any 26 of the foregoing enterprises in providing, whether for themselves or other such enterprises, the customers or 27

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consumers of any such enterprise or enterprises, or the general public, technical, electronic, telephonic, telecommunications, and other similar services, including, without limitation, so-called "call centers," provided that substantially all the employees of any such enterprise employed at such new facility are engaged in providing such services.

8 "(2) To foster activities and policies conducive to 9 expansion of existing industries within either of the counties 10 or any city or town therein.

"(3) To acquire and develop land within the jurisdiction of either of the counties, or of any city or town therein, for use as an industrial park or site by any enterprise described in subdivision (1).

"(4) To construct buildings for lease or other
disposition to enterprises described in subdivision (1),
including, without limitation, buildings suitable for use as
administrative offices of any such enterprise.

"(5) To pay administrative and other costs or 19 20 expenses, other than expenses of members of the committee, 21 whether or not such expenses may be reimbursed pursuant to 22 Section 45-17-91.24 and otherwise to provide for the general operations of the authority, provided that no more than 10 23 24 percent of the proceeds of the county sales and use taxes 25 deposited into the Shoals Economic Development Fund during 26 each calendar year may be expended during such calendar year 27 for such purposes.

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"(6) If and to the extent consistent with the 1 2 preceding provisions of this subsection, to assist the authority in the execution of its powers, and the performance 3 of its duties and obligations, under and pursuant to any laws 4 5 at any time pertaining to the authority, including, without limitation, Subpart 1 and Act 95-409, and any subsequent act 6 7 of the Legislature amending either or both thereof. Except to 8 the extent provided in the preceding provisions of this 9 subsection, none of the moneys and other properties, if any, 10 on deposit in the Shoals Economic Development Fund may be used to induce any commercial or retail establishment to locate 11 within either of the counties, any of the municipalities, or 12 13 any other city or town located, in whole or in part, in either of the counties, or to construct any building for sale, lease, 14 15 or other conveyance to, or use by, a commercial or retail establishment of any sort. Furthermore, nothing in this 16 17 subpart shall be construed to empower the committee to approve 18 the expenditure or appropriation of any such moneys or other properties in connection with the construction or operation of 19 20 any shopping center or similar facility, any hotel or 21 convention facility, any sports stadium or facility, any amusement or entertainment park or facility, or any comparable 22 23 or similar commercial or retail facility.

"(7) To expend an equal match of up to five million
dollars (\$5,000,000), which shall be expended to construct a
Workforce Training and Development Center on property owned by

Northwest-Shoals Community College the Lauderdale County
 Commission. The site of the center will be determined.

3 "(8) To expend an equal match of up to five million 4 dollars (\$5,000,000), which shall be expended for workforce 5 training and economic development programs at the University 6 of North Alabama.

7 "(d) Any moneys authorized, pursuant to this 8 subpart, to be expended by either the authority or any other 9 recipient shall, if not expended for the purpose or purposes 10 approved by the committee, be promptly returned to and 11 deposited into the Shoals Economic Development Fund.

"(e) It is the express intent of the Legislature 12 13 that all expenditures of moneys at any time on deposit in the 14 Shoals Economic Development Fund be made to promote the economic development of the citizens of each of the counties 15 and every city or town therein, to create and provide for the 16 17 creation of non-retail job opportunities that support salaries 18 at or above the estimated entry wage per occupation, as established by the most recent wage survey of the State of 19 20 Alabama, and to enable the committee and the participating 21 governments to support (1) the establishment and promotion of 22 business and industry in the Shoals area, (2) the development of trade and commerce in the Shoals area, (3) the furtherance 23 24 of the use of the agricultural products and natural resources 25 of the State of Alabama, and (4) the development and 26 preservation of such resources. However, the Legislature 27 recognizes and acknowledges that the authority and other

potential recipients of moneys on deposit in the Shoals 1 2 Economic Development Fund may be empowered by law to engage in activities, or to perform functions, for purposes that are 3 different from, or that are unrelated to, the purposes for 4 5 which such moneys are authorized by this subpart to be expended. It is therefore also the intent of the Legislature 6 7 that no moneys on deposit in the Shoals Economic Development Fund be expended by, or appropriated to, either the authority 8 or any such other recipient for any purpose or project except 9 10 those described in this subpart. Any expenditure or appropriation permitted by the preceding provisions of this 11 section to be made out of moneys on deposit in the Shoals 12 13 Economic Development Fund, and any such use of other 14 properties contributed to any such fund, shall be deemed an 15 expenditure or use, as the case may be, for a public purpose."

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective 17 immediately following its passage and approval by the 18 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
