SYNOPSIS: This bill would authorize the State Board of
Chiropractic Examiners to set reasonable fees for
certain services provided by the board in amounts
to be determined by rule of board.

TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to the State Board of Chiropractic
Examiners; to add Section 34-24-146 to the Code of Alabama
1975, to authorize the board to set reasonable fees by rule of
the board for certain services provided by the board.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 34-24-146 is added to the Code of
Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

§34-24-146.

The state Board of Chiropractic Examiners, by rule
of the board, may set, charge, and collect reasonable fees for

1 services provided by the board, including, but not limited to,
2 the following services:

3 (1) Applications for approval of continuing
4 education seminars.

5 (2) Verification of licensure status of licensees.

6 (3) Copies of records provided by the board.

7 (4) Other services as determined necessary by the
8 board to reimburse the board for expenses reasonably related
9 to the delivery of the services.

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective
11 immediately following its passage and approval by the
12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
