A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to Cherokee County; to provide for the compensation of the revenue commissioner and the sheriff effective beginning the next term of office; and to provide for the continuing annual training of the sheriff.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Effective beginning the next term of office, the Revenue Commissioner of Cherokee County shall receive an annual salary that is 85 percent of the annual salary of the Judge of Probate of Cherokee County, except as otherwise provided in Section 4.

Section 2. Effective beginning with the next term of office, the Sheriff of Cherokee County shall receive an annual salary that is 60 percent of the annual salary of the District Attorney of the Ninth Judicial Circuit, except as otherwise provided in Section 4.

1 Section 3. Effective beginning with the next term of
2 office, the Sheriff of Cherokee County shall annually complete
3 a minimum of 12 hours of executive level training approved by
4 the Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission.

5 Section 4. Sections 1 and 2 do not apply if the
6 result would be a reduction in the annual salary of the
7 revenue commissioner or sheriff.

8 Section 5. This act shall become effective
9 immediately following its passage and approval by the
10 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
