1	"There shall be a probate court in each county which
2	that shall have general jurisdiction of orphans' business, and
3	of adoptions, and with the power to grant letters
4	testamentary, and of administration, and of guardianships, and
5	shall have such further jurisdiction as may be provided by
6	law, provided, that whenever the circuit court has taken
7	jurisdiction of the settlement of any estate, it shall have
8	power to do all things necessary for the settlement of such
9	estate, including the appointment and removal of
10	administrators, executors, guardians, and trustees and
11	including action upon the resignation of either of them."
12	END OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:
