22 supporter of the Alabama Kidney Foundation, funded the Hilda  
23 B. Anderson Endowed Chair in Nephrology at The University of  
24 Alabama at Birmingham, and funded an endowed professorship  
25 dedicated to kidney research; and

1           WHEREAS, she was an avid fan of women's sports who  
2           made generous contributions to the women's softball program at  
3           The University of North Alabama; the university's complex  
4           stadium now bears her name, the Hilda B. Anderson Softball  
5           Stadium; in recent years, she gifted an additional donation to  
6           the softball program and to each of the other seven women's  
7           athletic teams at the university; and

8           WHEREAS, a loving wife and a devoted mother, Mrs.  
9           Anderson loved cooking for her family and supporting her four  
10          sons' many sports endeavors; and

11          WHEREAS, she was preceded in death by her parents;  
12          and her sisters, Doris Barbour Duncan and Norma Jean Barbour  
13          Box; and

14          WHEREAS, Mrs. Anderson is survived by her husband of  
15          67 years, Charles Caine Anderson, Sr.; brother-in-law, Joel  
16          Ray Anderson; sister-in-law, Jan Anderson Wiggins (Bob); sons,  
17          Charles Caine Anderson, Jr. (Moll), Terrence Carroll Anderson  
18          (Susan), Clyde Barbour Anderson (Summer), and Harold Myron
