10 WHEREAS, a loving wife and a devoted mother, Mrs.
11 Anderson loved cooking for her family and supporting her four
12 sons' many sports endeavors; and

13 WHEREAS, she was preceded in death by her parents;
14 and her sisters, Doris Barbour Duncan and Norma Jean Barbour

16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Anderson is survived by her husband of
17 67 years, Charles Caine Anderson, Sr.; brother-in-law, Joel
18 Ray Anderson; sister-in-law, Jan Anderson Wiggins (Bob); sons,
19 Charles Caine Anderson, Jr. (Moll), Terrence Carroll Anderson
20 (Susan), Clyde Barbour Anderson (Summer), and Harold Myron
