the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners in 1981 and served with 1 2 distinction until his retirement in 2016, at which time he was honored with the renaming of their building, as the 3 Dixon-Parker Building; he served and was elected to the 4 5 following during his years of service: the Montgomery City Council, the Alabama House of Representatives and lastly the 6 7 Alabama Senate; he was also included in the Alabama Health Care Hall of Fame; he is remembered as a man of character who 8 9 fought for transparency and fiscal conservatism; and

10 WHEREAS, Senator Dixon also accomplished and was 11 honored at the national level as a four-term Board Member of 12 the United States Federation of State Medical Boards and as a 13 founder of Administrators in Medicine, which he served as the 14 first President and received a Lifetime Achievement Award; and
