5 EXTENDING THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMITTEE ON  
6 VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS AND COMMUNITY MEDICAL RESPONDERS.

8 WHEREAS, the Joint Legislative Study Committee on  
9 Volunteer Fire Departments and Community Medical Responders  
10 was created by the Legislature during the 2020 Regular Session  
11 (Act 2020-205), to identify the causes of barriers to  
12 recruitment of new volunteers in order to formulate  
13 appropriate solutions and to make recommendations regarding  
14 those potential solutions to the Legislature; and

15 WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has unequivocally  
16 impeded efforts to accomplish the goals of the study  
17 committee, thus necessitating an extension of the study  
18 committee; now therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
20 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Joint Legislative Study  
21 Committee on Volunteer Fire Departments and Community Medical  
22 Responders, created in Act 2020-205, is extended through the  
23 last legislative day of the 2022 Regular Session to continue  
24 its efforts to identify the causes of barriers to recruitment  
25 of new volunteers in order to formulate appropriate solutions

1 and to make recommendations regarding those potential  
2 solutions to the Legislature.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint Legislative  
4 Study Committee on Volunteer Fire Departments and Community  
5 Medical Responders shall present a report and recommendations  
6 to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and the Legislature no  
7 later than the last legislative day of the 2022 Regular  
8 Session, at which time it shall stand dissolved.
