8 EXTENDING THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMITTEE ON
9 VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS AND COMMUNITY MEDICAL RESPONDERS.

11 WHEREAS, the Joint Legislative Study Committee on
12 Volunteer Fire Departments and Community Medical Responders
13 was created by the Legislature during the 2020 Regular Session
14 (Act 2020-205), to identify the causes of barriers to
15 recruitment of new volunteers in order to formulate
16 appropriate solutions and to make recommendations regarding
17 those potential solutions to the Legislature; and

18 WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has unequivocally
19 impeded efforts to accomplish the goals of the study
20 committee, thus necessitating an extension of the study
21 committee; now therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
23 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the Joint Legislative Study
24 Committee on Volunteer Fire Departments and Community Medical
25 Responders, created in Act 2020-205, is extended through the
26 last legislative day of the 2022 Regular Session to continue
27 its efforts to identify the causes of barriers to recruitment

1 of new volunteers in order to formulate appropriate solutions
2 and to make recommendations regarding those potential
3 solutions to the Legislature.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint Legislative
5 Study Committee on Volunteer Fire Departments and Community
6 Medical Responders shall present a report and recommendations
7 to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and the Legislature no
8 later than the last legislative day of the 2022 Regular
9 Session, at which time it shall stand dissolved.
