4 courage, cheer, and service, the five integral
5 responsibilities of a Scout; and

7 printing over 300 face shields during the COVID-19 pandemic;
8 he provided Personal Protective Equipment for front-line,
9 essential workers at multiple local hospitals; and

11 participates in extracurricular activities and has devoted
12 many volunteer hours to worthy community projects; and

13 WHEREAS, through the years, Carter has exhibited
14 those hard-won characteristics of trustworthiness,
15 self-discipline, and good citizenship, all components of the
16 Scouting program; with the guidance and support of his local
17 Scouting leaders, he has earned the esteem of his community,
18 fellow Scouts, and all Alabamians; now therefore,
