1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. Section 29-1-1.2, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the existing House districts, is repealed. 3 Section 2. Section 29-1-1.2 is added to the Code of 4 5 Alabama 1975, to read as follows: \$29-1-1.2. 6 7 (a) The Alabama House of Representatives shall consist of 105 members. Each member elected shall reside in 8 the district which he or she represents or seeks to represent. 9 10 The State of Alabama is divided into 105 House Districts as provided in subsection (b). 11 (b) The numbers and boundaries of the districts are 12 13 designated and established by the map prepared by the 14 Permanent Legislative Committee on Reapportionment and

15 identified and labeled as Pringle House Plan 4, including the 16 corresponding boundary description provided by the census 17 tracts, blocks, and counties, and are incorporated by 18 reference as part of this section.

(c) The Legislature shall post for viewing on its 19 20 public website the map referenced in subsection (b), including 21 the corresponding boundary description provided by the census tracts, blocks, and counties, and any alternative map, 22 23 including the corresponding boundary description provided by 24 the census tracts, blocks, and counties, introduced by any 25 member of the Legislature during the legislative session in which this section is added or amended. 26

(d) Upon enactment of the act adding this section
and adopting the map identified in subsection (b), the Clerk
of the House of Representatives shall transmit the map and the
corresponding boundary description provided by the census
tracts, blocks, and counties identified in subsection (b) for
certification and posting on the public website of the
Secretary of State.

8 (e) The boundary descriptions provided by the 9 certified map referenced in subsection (b) shall prevail over 10 the boundary descriptions provided by the census tracts, 11 blocks, and counties generated for the map.

Section 3. The provisions of this act are severable.
If any part of this act is declared invalid or
unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part
which remains.

16 Section 4. This act shall become effective 17 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or 18 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
