9 and Career Pathways; he was a graduate of Leadership Alabama
10 and was named to Mobile Bay Magazine's Top 40 Under 40; and

12 grandparents, Captain Martin Dale Schjott and wife, Naomi
13 Marie "Gommie" Cain Schjott; maternal grandmother; Mary Alma
14 Bellina; and brother, John Schjott; and

16 Schjott and Stephanie Kihm Schjott; sisters, Kathleen Lynne
17 Schjott (Patrick Ryan Johnson), and Sabrina Jean Schjott;
