- 3 (b) No entity or individual may compel receipt of a
 4 COVID-19 vaccine by any individual, including an employee or a
 5 consumer, who objects to the vaccination for any reason of
 6 personal conscience, based on a religious belief, or for
 7 medical reasons, including recovery from COVID-19.
- 8 (c) An entity or individual that violates this
 9 section is subject to a one thousand dollar (\$1,000) fine for
 10 each violation of this section.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
