JOE EDWARD FULLER. 8 9 10 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the death on October 8, 2021, of Mr. Joe Edward "The Hawk" Fuller, 11 12 at the age of 78; and 13 WHEREAS, his passing leaves a void in the lives of his loving family, many friends, and the entire community, 14 15 where he was highly regarded; and WHEREAS, Mr. Fuller was born on June 29, 1943, in 16 17 Huntsville, Alabama; he was adopted at birth by Joe Drennen 18 Fuller and Nancy Irene White Fuller; after the passing of Joe 19 Drennen Fuller, Walter Stead became Mr. Fuller's adopted 20 stepfather; and 21 WHEREAS, Mr. Fuller attended Columbia Military 22 Academy in Tennessee, The University of Georgia at Warner 23 Robins Air Force Base, and Samford University; and 24 WHEREAS, in 1961, Mr. Fuller joined the United 25 States Air Force and served honorably until 1965, during which time he gained his nickname, "The Hawk," due to his precision 26 on the rifle range; in 1968, he joined his stepfather at the 27

1 Walter Stead Agency, which became the Stead and Fuller Agency 2 in 1977 when Mr. Fuller became partner; in 2019, he partnered 3 with his son-in-law, CD Denson, and changed the name of the 4 agency to Stead, Denson, and Fuller Insurance, Inc.; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Fuller, who was known as the "Political King Maker," had a true passion for service to his community 6 7 and was an active leader in numerous civic, professional, and 8 political organizations and causes; he served for two terms as 9 President of the Birmingham Jaycees, two terms as President of 10 the City Sales Club, two terms as President of the Mid-Alabama Republican Club, and two terms as Chairman of the Birmingham 11 Regional Chamber of Commerce; some of his other achievements 12 13 included serving as Chairman of the Jefferson County March of 14 Dimes Walk-A-Thon; State and National Director for the Alabama 15 Independent Insurance Agents Association; Past President of Professional Insurance Agents of Alabama; Chairman of the 16 17 Corridor X Task Force, where he spearheaded the development 18 and completion of the Memphis to Birmingham interstate, now known as I-22; having a bridge along the route at the 19 20 Jefferson-Walker County line named in his honor by the Alabama 21 Legislature; and being named President Emeritus for his 44 years of service to the Birmingham City Sales Club, receiving 22 23 the Alabama Independent Insurance Agents Insuror of the Year 24 Award in 2014 and having the Joe E. "Hawk" Fuller Lawmaker of 25 the Year Award/The Hawk Award, an award that is bestowed annually in perpetuity to a deserving legislator, created in 26

his honor in 2021; he also served on the Board of Directors
 for the Birmingham-Jefferson Convention Complex; and

3 WHEREAS, along with being passionate about serving 4 others and loving his family and friends endlessly, Mr. Fuller 5 was also devoted to Christ; and

6 WHEREAS, he was preceded in death by his adopted 7 father; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Fuller is survived by his beloved wife 8 9 of 21 years, Vickie Evans Fuller; daughters, Lesleigh Fuller 10 Carmichael (Jamey), Lura Fuller Denson (CD), and Sydney Fuller McDonough (Griffin); grandchildren, Anna Lauryn Carmichael, 11 Karaley Brooke Carmichael, Martha Mae Sara Denson, Jackson 12 13 Ryan McDonough, Fuller Barrow Denson, and Emma Claire McDonough; half-brother, Lehman Stegall; half-sisters, Ada 14 15 Duos and Michelle Brown; and a host of dear friends; and

16 WHEREAS, although his presence will be greatly 17 missed, the memory of Mr. Fuller will be cherished in the 18 hearts of all who knew and loved him; now therefore,
