5 municipality approves of the issuance of the license for the
6 food truck to sell alcoholic beverages.

7 (d) The food truck license fee shall be three
8 hundred dollars (\$300).

9 (e) A food truck operating outside the designated
10 entertainment district may not sell alcoholic beverages.

11 (f) A food truck licensee shall consent, in writing,
12 to warrantless inspections by city, county, and state
13 inspectors and law enforcement.

14 (g) A truck licensee must comply with all
15 on-premises rules, other than the requirement for seating and
16 restrooms.
