8 On page 1, delete lines 8 through 10 in their
9 entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

10 This bill would provide that only 10 percent of a
11 municipality's general operating budget may come from fines
12 and penalties retained by a municipality from traffic tickets.

14 On page 1, after line 14, insert the following:

15 Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of
16 1901, as amended by Amendment 890, now appearing as Section
17 111.05 of the Official ReCompilation of the Constitution of
18 Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general law whose
19 purpose or effect would be to require a new or increased
20 expenditure of local funds from becoming effective with regard
21 to a local governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote
22 unless: it comes within one of a number of specified
23 exceptions; it is approved by the affected entity; or the
24 Legislature appropriates funds, or provides a local source of
25 revenue, to the entity for the purpose.

26 The purpose or effect of this bill would be to
27 require a new or increased expenditure of local funds within

1 the meaning of the amendment. If this bill is not enacted by a
2 2/3 vote, it will not become effective with regard to a local
3 entity unless approved by the local entity or until, and only
4 as long as, the Legislature appropriates funds or provides for
5 a local source of revenue.

7 On page 1, line 22, after "tickets" insert the
8 following:

9 ; and in connection therewith to have as its purpose
10 or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of
11 local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the
12 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended by Amendment 890,
13 now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation
14 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended

16 On page 1, delete lines 24 through 26 in their
17 entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

18 Section 1. (a) Only 10 percent of a municipality's
19 general operating budget may come from fines and penalties
20 retained by a municipality from traffic tickets. Any

22 On page 2, after line 8, insert a new Section 2 and
23 renumber the remaining section accordingly:

24 Section 2. The purpose or effect of this bill would
25 be to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds
26 within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the Constitution of
27 Alabama of 1901, as amended by Amendment 890, now appearing as

1 Section 111.05 of the Official ReCompilation of the
2 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended. If this bill is
3 not enacted by a 2/3 vote, it will not become effective with
4 regard to a local entity unless approved by the local entity
5 or until, and only as long as, the Legislature appropriates
6 funds or provides for a local source of revenue.
