10 (a) Enrollment. Each start-up public charter school
11 shall report ~~such~~

12 On page 2, line 23 after "." insert the following:

13 In their initial year, operational funding prior to
14 the beginning of the fiscal year shall be provided from the
15 Education Trust Fund appropriation for current units.

16 On page 4, line 6, after the "." insert the
17 following:

18 For the purposes of allocation of countywide taxes
19 under Section 16-13-31, public charter schools are considered
20 a local board of education. Any public charter school that
21 receives countywide taxes pursuant to this paragraph shall not
22 receive any allocation of state Foundation Program funding in
23 excess of the proportionate amount allocated to non-charter
24 public schools.

25 On page 4, delete lines 8-10, and insert the
26 following:

1 of less than 40,000, the State Department of
2 Education shall provide the 10 mill match requirement for
3 Foundation Program participation from state funds appropriated
4 for the Foundation Program to the start-up public charter
5 school. Any start-up public charter school located in a county
6 with a population of less than 40,000 shall not receive any
7 countywide revenue.

8 On page 4, line 19, delete "Nothing in"

9 On page 4, delete lines 20-25 in their entirety

10 On page 5, line 2, strike "b." and insert "c."

11 On page 5, lines 4-5, strike "of the student's
12 residence"

13 On page 5, line 6, after "16-6F-6." insert the
14 following:

15 Additionally, any local revenues committed by
16 statutory provision, constitutional provision, or broad
17 resolution, pledged or imposed by formal action of the local
18 board of education or other authorizing body of government,
19 prior to the date of this act, shall not be included in the
20 allocation of countywide taxes pursuant to paragraph c.
