9 On page 1, line 14, delete "until May 30, 2032,"

11 On page 21, line 8, delete "2032," and insert in
12 lieu thereof: 2027,

14 On page 21, line 16, after the period insert the
15 following:

16 The exemption authorized by this subsection shall
17 not be available for sales of parts, components, or systems
18 for new contracts or projects entered into after May 30, 2027,
19 unless the Legislature enacts legislation to continue or
20 reinstate the exemption for new contracts or projects after
21 that date. No action or inaction on the part of the
22 Legislature shall reduce, suspend, or disqualify sales of
23 parts, components, or systems from the exemption in any past
24 year or future years until May 30, 2030, with respect to
25 contracts or projects entered into on or before May 30, 2027;
26 it being the sole intent that failure of the Legislature to
27 enact legislation to reinstate the exemption for new contracts

1 or projects after May 30, 2027, shall affect only the
2 availability of the exemption to new contracts and projects
3 after that date and shall not affect availability of the
4 exemption for contracts or projects entered into on or before
5 May 30, 2027, for which the exemption shall be available until
6 May 30, 2030.

8 On page 24, after line 15, insert the following new
9 Section 2 and renumber the subsequent section accordingly:

10 Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of
11 this chapter to the contrary, no exemption provided by
12 existing law in this chapter shall be extended, expanded, or
13 modified by a Joint Resolution of the Legislature. Any Joint
14 Resolution passed in violation of this provision shall be null
15 and void.
