20	(2) No student of a public K-12 school may be
21	allowed to participate in school counseling services
22	including, but not limited to, mental health services, unless
23	specific written instruction has been granted by the student's
24	parent. For the purposes of this section, this written
25	permission is referred to as an opt-in.
26	(3) All local boards of education in this state
27	shall adopt a policy concerning parent opt-in for mental

health services. At a minimum, each policy shall contain the following:

- a. A provision for written notification, at least annually, to parents about school provided or sponsored mental health services. The notification shall include the purpose and general description of each of the mental health services, information regarding ways parents may review materials to be used in guidance and counseling programs that are available to students, and information regarding ways parents may allow, limit, or prevent their student's participation in the programs.
 - b. A provision requiring written permission by a parent for his or her student to participate in mental health services. This written permission shall be specific and not broad in nature. This permission shall also be required annually and may be rescinded at any time by providing written notice to school administration.
 - c. If a parent elects to opt-in to mental health services for his or her student, the counselor providing the services shall keep the parent fully informed regarding diagnosis, recommended counseling, guidance, or treatments, and the parent shall have the authority to make final decisions regarding counseling, guidance, and treatments.
 - d. A provision requiring all records pertaining to mental health services to be treated as health care records and kept separately from academic records.
