8	Relating to Baldwin County; to amend Section
9	45-2-60, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to compensation of the
10	county coroner, to provide further for the compensation of the
11	coroner; and to make nonsubstantive, technical revisions to
12	update the existing code language to current style.
13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. Section 45-2-60 , Code of Alabama 1975,
15	is amended to read as follows:
16	"§45-2-60.
17	"(a) The coroner of Baldwin County shall receive an
18	additional expense allowance of five hundred dollars (\$500)
19	per month which shall be paid from the county general funds.
20	The expense allowance shall be in addition to any salary and
21	other expense allowance heretofore provided to such officer.
22	"(b)(1) The Coroner of Baldwin County shall receive
23	an additional expense allowance not to exceed six hundred
24	dollars (\$600) per month, the amount of which shall be
25	determined by the county governing body and paid from the
26	county general fund. The expense allowance shall be in
27	addition to any salary and other expense allowance heretofore

1	provided to the coroner, including the expense allowance
2	provided in subsection (a).
3	"(2) Beginning with the expiration of the term of
4	the incumbent coroner, the salary for the coroner shall be
5	increased by the amount of the then existing expense money
6	allowable, payable in equal monthly installments from the
7	general fund of the county and at that time subdivision (1)
8	shall become null and void.
9	"(b) The coroner shall receive an annual salary of
10	fifty-two thousand dollars (\$52,000) in lieu of any and all
11	other salary, not including any expense allowance, now
12	provided by law. This salary shall be payable in equal monthly
13	installments from the general fund of the county.
14	"(c) $\underline{(1)}$ In Baldwin County, the coroner shall be
15	entitled to the same cost of living increase percentage
16	granted to other public officials pursuant to Act 2000-108.
17	"(2) If an increase pursuant to this subsection is
18	due during the term of the coroner, the increase shall be in
19	the form of an expense allowance which will convert to salary
20	effective the next term of office."
21	"(d) The coroner shall be authorized to participate
22	in any health insurance benefits and retirement benefits to
23	the same extent as any county employee."
24	Section 2. This act shall become effective on
25	January 16, 2023, following its passage and approval by the

Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
