8 Relating to Baldwin County; to provide for an
9 additional expense allowance and salary for the sheriff; and
10 to repeal Sections 45-2-230 and 45-2-230.02, Code of Alabama
11 1975, providing for the compensation of the sheriff.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

13 Section 1. Commencing on the effective date of this
14 act, the Sheriff of Baldwin County shall receive an additional
15 expense allowance in an amount so that the total compensation
16 of the sheriff is one hundred thirty thousand dollars
17 (\$130,000) per year. This expense allowance shall be payable
18 in equal monthly installments from the general fund of the
19 county.

20 Section 2. (a) Commencing with the next term of
21 office of the Sheriff of Baldwin County, the sheriff shall
22 receive an annual salary of one hundred thirty thousand
23 dollars (\$130,000) in lieu of any and all compensation now
24 provided by law.

25 (b) Commencing with the next term of office of the
26 Sheriff of Baldwin County, should any employee of the office
27 of the Sheriff of Baldwin County receive a cost-of-living

1 compensation adjustment, that same cost-of-living adjustment
2 shall apply to the sheriff's ~~salary~~ compensation. Any increase
3 granted to the sheriff pursuant to this subsection shall be
4 disbursed to the sheriff as an expense allowance until the end
5 of that term of office as sheriff, at which time the increase
6 shall be converted to salary.

7 Section 3. Sections 45-2-230 and 45-2-230.02, Code
8 of Alabama 1975, providing for the compensation of the Sheriff
9 of Baldwin County, are repealed.

10 Section 4. This act shall become effective
11 immediately following its passage and approval by the
12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
