Relating to the Department of Insurance; to direct the Commissioner of Insurance to transfer from the Insurance Department Fund to the Strengthen Alabama Homes Fund any amount remaining in the Insurance Department Fund on September 30, 2022, which exceeded 25 percent of the amount appropriated for the Insurance Department Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022; to authorize the Commissioner of Insurance to transfer up to 50 percent of the amount appropriated each fiscal year from the Insurance Department Fund; and to add Section 27-31E-4 to the Code of Alabama 1975, to provide additional qualifications for contractors who perform retrofitting work to the Strengthen Alabama Homes Fund.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The Notwithstanding Section 27-2-39, the Commissioner of Insurance shall transfer from the Insurance Department Fund to the Strengthen Alabama Homes Fund any amount remaining in the Insurance Department Fund on September 30, 2022, which exceeded 25 percent of the amount appropriated for the Insurance Department Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022.

Section 2. The Commissioner of Insurance may transfer to the Strengthen Alabama Homes Fund from the Insurance Department Fund up to 50 percent of the amount
