8 Relating to counties; to prohibit a county from
9 charging a farmer a license or other fee for the sale of farm
10 products produced by the farmer.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 ~~Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of~~
13 ~~law, it shall be unlawful for a county to charge a farmer or~~
14 ~~others engaged in the production of farm products of whatever~~
15 ~~nature any license or other fee for the sale or other~~
16 ~~disposition of farm products produced by the farmer at any~~
17 ~~place.~~

18 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, it shall
19 be unlawful for a county to charge a farmer, a member of his
20 or her immediate family, or his or her employees engaged in
21 the production of farm products as defined in Section 2-6B-2,
22 Code of Alabama 1975, or farm products to which a producer
23 adds value, any business license or other similar fee for the
24 sale or other disposition of farm products produced by the
25 farmer, a member of his or her immediate family, or his or her
26 employees at any place.

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
